Bordenball

Question	Answer
In Bordenball are you allowed to intercept and slam the ball down to the ground to gain possession as long as there is no body contact? Or do you have to catch it to be an interception.	Same rules as ultimate, you can knock the ball down or catch it. If you catch it you can shoot right away but if you knock it down a pass must be made first before a shoot can be taken.
Can you pivot after your 3 steps?	Yes, sam as basketball
Can you deflect the ball into the net or do you have to throw it?	The ball would need to have initially come from a pass from your own team. You cannot knock an opponent's pass into the net to score.
When you're guarding someone, how far do you have to be?	You need to provide ability for the player to pivot, similar to basketball and ultimate.
What happens when the ball hits the wall or the ceiling?	It is out of bounds and a turnover occurs. The court is outlined by sidelines before the wall. Usually the basketball court lines.
Is there a out of bounds?	See above
When a player picks up the ball after the other team loses possession, can he/she do 3 steps before passing?	No a pass must occur first.
Can we play zone defence or must it be man to man?	Must be man to man. Preparation for basketball
When do you go half court?	After a shot and a goal.
Do players walk the ball to half court, after a shot or goal, or may they quickly toss it to half court (regardless of whether it's dropped)?	After a shot the goalie gets the ball and pass it from his/her crease. If it is dropped it is a turnover and the other team gets to come into the zone and start from the ball drop spot,
Does the player get three steps + 3 seconds, with the ball?	They have three seconds with the ball, steps must be taken in those three seconds.
May the player take 3 seconds, then take three steps and pass/shoot?	No, see above answer
May the goalie leave the crease?	No, except to fetch a deadball (after a shot was taken).
After a shot/goal when can the opposing team defend? Is it only after the ball crosses half court?	The scoring/ shooting team must retreat to their own half and cannot cross the half to defend. However if the team with the ball drops a pass the other team can enter the zone to go on the offence.
